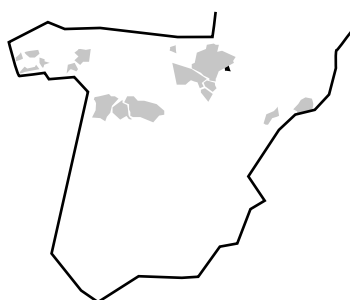

### Origin

This project is a tribute to the Garnacha grape, a variety historically forgotten and neglected because of its complicated viticulture. Proyecto Garnachas de España is a collection of monovarietal wines made in different areas of the Ebro Valley and from very old vineyards. Each wine expresses all the nuances and peculiarities of its own production area.



**Variety:** 100% Garnacha.

**Aging:** 12 months in French oak casks.




**Harvest:** Harvested by hand, 15th October.

**Vineyard:** Located at a height of 800 meters in Uncastillo, at the northern tip of the province of Zaragoza. Planted in 1999, ecological since planted. Southeast facing slopes with chalky clay soil, surrounded by typical Mediterranean forest. Low production (2-3 thousand kg / ha). Only natural treatments are applied and vegetation cover is maintained.

**Elaboration:** Fermentation in stainless steel and Malolactic fermentation in French oak.

**Alcohol content:** 15.5% Vol.

### Tasting notes

-  **Visual:** Bright robe, dark cherry red, garnet, very intense and vivid.
-  **Nose:** Delicate and highly complex. Intense aromas of violets and roses. Freshness provided by black fruits (blackberries, raspberries and cranberries), orange peel, pepper and balsamic flavors (dill, rosemary and laurel), typical of this variety grown at high altitudes.
-  **Palate:** Balanced and round, fresh and pleasant. Buttery on the palate with a persistent finish. Nice, ripe tannins. Postnasal aroma with spicy notes from aging and the balsamics of the variety.
